Eligible Breeds and Registry

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, Sloughis, Whippets may be entered in the regular stakes.

Provisional breeds may be entered in the Provisional Stake or the Singles Stake. Provisional breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno), Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande), and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (ILP/PAL included), the NGA, the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from the SPDBS. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the NGA.

Regular Stakes Offered

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record record that has met the certification requirements.

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Any ASFA Field Champion

VETERAN STAKE: Any eligible hound whose age is at least six years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least five years, and Afghan Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis and Whippets whose age shall be at least seven years, record that has obtained met the certification requirements. Points go toward V-FCh or V-LCM titles.

PROVISIONAL STAKE: Any eligible sighthound of a Provisional breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field. **SINGLES STAKE:** Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles stake. Provisional breeds are not eligible for these titles.

We will hold practice on Saturday after the trial is complete for \$3/run.


Directions—GPS/MAP TO "99 Glendale Rd., Limestone TN 37681"





For First Time Coursers and Handlers

- WHAT ARE PRE-ENTRIES? Entries made before the closing date. If your entry is mailed in time yet due to the failure of the postal service it is not received in time for the Test Secretary to have it at the Event, then you will have to fill out day of entry forms on the day of the trial. Always have your dog's registration materials with you when you go to a test.
- WHAT ARE "DAY OF" ENTRIES? Entries accepted after the closing date for pre-entries are considered Day of Entries. The deadline for Preentries is typically two days before the event. "Day of' entries are usually more expensive because the Field Test Secretary (FTS) must take extra time to add those entries to the record sheets the morning of the test, which delays the start of the trial. If you are entering on the day of the test, you MUST have your completed entry to the Test Secretary BEFORE Roll Call.
- SLIP LEADS There is a type of collar for coursing called a slip lead, which is worn only to control the dog prior to release. The collar drops away as the dog is released to chase the lure and they run without anything around their necks that could be dangerous. SLIP LEADS WILL BE PROVIDED
- INSPECTION Dogs will be inspected by a designated Inspection Committee consisting of at least two persons who are members of the Field Committee and who shall inspect each entered dog for lameness, fitness to compete and female estrus (in season). Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the Inspection Committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete or in season shall not be allowed to enter and the applicable entry fees shall be refunded.
- ROLL CALL The time, prior to the commencement of coursing, by which you are supposed to have your dog ready for inspection by the Inspection Committee. At roll call the dog is examined for lameness, and breed disqualifications (where applicable). Unspayed bitches are examined to see if they show any evidence of being in season. After roll call the list of passed hounds is taken to the Field Test Secretary so that the run order can be prepared.
- RUN ORDER LIST This is a posted list of the running order for the dogs participating in the event. Always check the record sheet after the Roll Call to confirm your dog's Run Order.

COVID-19 Guidelines

- 1. GASM, its club members and all exhibitors will follow <u>State</u> and <u>local</u> guidelines.
- Though food will be served, you are welcome to bring your own breakfast and lunches. While ordering and preparing food, please maintain safe distances.
- 3. We ask that you park at a safe distance away from each other.
- 4. We will ask the owners of females to wipe their dogs and show the inspection committee the tissue.
- The temperatures of exhibitors may be checked during Roll Call or when in question using a forehead, no-touch thermometer. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4° F or higher will be considered febrile and asked to leave the property.
- 6. Wickets will be wiped down after each dog.
- 7. We will have instant hand sanitizer or wet wipes in various locations for use.
- 8. We will prop open the portipotties when not in use for more air flow.
- 9. Huntmasters will stand 6 feet from the dogs inspecting blankets and slip leads.
- 10. At the starting line, all exhibitors will stand 6 feet apart from one another.
- 11. Practice social distancing the best you can.
- 12. While the running order and scores will be posted as usual, we ask that exhibitors approach the sheets one at a time and maintain social distance guidelines.
- 13. No self-serve ribbons anymore due to cross contamination.
- 14. Exhibitors who refuse to comply when reasonably asked to follow mask, sanitary or social distancing guidelines will be removed from the property.
