

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

1. GASM, its club members and exhibitors will follow all applicable state and local guidelines in place at the time of the race meet.
2. Any unvaccinated Field Committee members and Lure Operators will wear facial coverings and gloves.
3. All unvaccinated participants must wear facial coverings.
4. The roll call committee will wear facial coverings. We will ask the owners of females to wipe their dogs and show the inspection committee the tissue.
5. The temperatures of exhibitors may be checked during Roll Call or when in question using a forehead, no-touch thermometer. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4°F or higher will be considered febrile and asked to leave the property.
6. We will have instant hand sanitizer or wipes in various locations throughout the property. We will prop open the porta-potties when not in use for more air flow.
7. Please keep 6 feet apart from one another whenever possible.
8. Hounds should be loaded into starting boxes one at a time, with handlers standing 6 feet apart from one another.
9. While the running order and scores will be posted as usual, we ask that exhibitors approach the sheets one at a time and maintain social distance guidelines.
10. Exhibitors who refuse to comply when reasonably asked to follow mask, sanitary or social distancing guidelines will be removed from the property.

ROLL CALL AND INSPECTION: 8:30 AM Saturday and Sunday. Hounds not present at roll call will be marked absent and are not eligible for refund of entry fee.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 5th place.

HELPING OTHERS: This kind of event requires much help from everyone involved, from (walking dogs, releasing hounds, retrieving hounds at the finish, line judging and foul judging). LUNCH: Provided on the field for a \$5 donation or you can bring your own.

CARE OF YOUR HOUNDS: Please bring plenty of drinking water and shade for your hounds, as it can still be quite hot in late September.

PORTA-POTTIES AND TRASH: Please do not dispose of poop bags in porta-potties. All participants are expected to ensure that the grounds are kept clean of trash and all dog poop is picked up and disposed of properly.

WHAT IS LGRA?

LGRA is sprint racing for Gazeounds. The hounds run 200 yards straight after a lure consisting of a fur, bag and squawker. Up to four hounds race a total of three times, called programs. Depending on the order of finish, they may attain national points towards a GRC, Gazehound Race Champion, title. All breeds will be using a 6 hole starting box; no hand slipping will be permitted at this race meet with the exception of Irish Wolfhounds. Each box stall measures 34 inches in height, 48 inches in depth, and a width of 11 inches. Hounds need to be one year of age or older to be entered. They will also need to be registered with LGRA. This can be done the morning of the race meet by bringing a photocopy of the hound's registration along with a \$2 fee. After registration, your hound will receive a LGRA number that will be used in entering future LGRA meets. To receive further information, please contact Terry Colbert, Race Secretary, by e-mail at terryacolbert@yahoo.com. All hounds will run muzzled. A small supply of muzzles and racing jackets will be available but please bring your own supplies if possible.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS: Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenji, Borzoi, Chart Polski, Cirneco dell'Etnas, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Magyar Agars, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, and Silken Windhounds (UKC registration papers required).

ENTRY FEES: The entry fee for each hound will be \$10 if the entry is received by the Race Secretary by the end of Wednesday, September 22, 2021.

You will be expected to have complete info on your dog for each entry. Incomplete entries and those not submitted on the form in the premium or on the online form will not be accepted. Entries will not be acknowledged by mail or email.

Expect 20-30 minute travel times from most hotels. Google Maps works well. Verizon has the best cell coverage, but reception on the field may be spotty.

From I-81 (N, E, W) (12 mins): NEVER USE EXIT 44. Take exit 50 for TN-93 south for 1.8 miles. Continue straight onto TN-81 for 2.2 miles. Right on Cherry Hill Rd for .6 miles. Bear left to Martin Rd. for .9 miles. Right on Glendale for 2.7 miles.

From I-26 (S) (40 mins): Take exit 37 north on TN-107/TN-81 for about 22 miles. Follow signs for TN-81N through Jonesborough. After passing the Marathon, keep an eye out for a sharp right turn, where you'll continue straight onto Pleasant Grove Rd. for .8 miles. Turn right onto Glendale Rd for 3.4 miles.

BRIDGE OUT! The cement bridge from 81 to Providence Rd. is out! That means you will have to follow the the detour route to Oak Hill Cir.

***NEW* RV NOTICE!** Highly advised that you come in via: I81 -> Hwy 93 (Exit 50) -> Hwy 81N -> Oak Hill Cir (Across from Oak Hill Baptist Church) → Oak Hill Rd. → Martin Rd. → Glendale Rd. Any other way will have turns/roads you will NOT want to take a rig or trailer down.
